We hope to collect more than 50,000 bags that will shine all across America as we bring hope home in 2021.

Easy Steps To Track Donations & Bags

- **1. SET UP**: Set-up your CANraiser fundraising page at fightcancer.org/hope. While on your personal page, take a moment to personalize the home page, adding in your story and a personal photo. Don't forget to change the URL to make it easier for family and friends to donate to your page.
- **2. ORDER**: Place orders for Lights of Hope bags through your ACS CAN staff partner. All Lights of Hope fundraisers should be prepared to decorate all their Lights of Hope bags for their own Lights of Hope displays. Electronic kit materials are available at FightCancer.org/LOHresources.
- **3. COLLECT**: Collect donations for Lights of Hope bags for a *minimum* donation of \$10 per bag. You have two options for collecting donations: by inviting friends and family to visit your CANRaiser page to make their donations online or accepting the donation via cash/check (offline donation).
- **4. TRACK**: ALL donations and bags must be entered onto your CANRaiser page so we can track our nationwide progress. All online donations to your personal page will automatically be entered. All offline donations need to be entered by you in the "offline donations" section.
- **5. SUBMIT**: Turn in all donations to your staff partner for processing on or before the fundraising deadline September 20, 2021.

Per legal requirements, Relay For Life Luminaria bags may not be used for Lights of Hope.

If staff and volunteers can travel to Washington D.C. for Leadership Summit and Lobby Day in September, a modified in person activity will be hosted on September 28, 2021.
