

Cancer patients and survivors — our family, friends, neighbors and co-workers — rely on Medicaid.




Nearly **62 million**

2007-2015




Nearly **70%** of

women




Over **30%** of

Medicaid enrollees with a cancer diagnosis are a cross-section of the population

- ★ **30%** have a high school diploma or GED
- ★ **17%** have completed a bachelors or associates degree
- ★ **1 in 12** have served in the armed forces
- ★ **1 in 6** worked in the last 12 months
