Cancer patients and survivors — our family, friends, neighbors and co-workers — rely on Medicaid.




Nearly **2 million** North Carolinians are covered by Medicaid



Nearly **20,000** North Carolinians with cancer relied on Medicaid coverage 2007-2015




Nearly **70%** of North Carolina Medicaid enrollees with cancer are women




Over **30%** of North Carolina Medicaid enrollees with cancer are men

Medicaid enrollees with a cancer diagnosis are a cross-section of North Carolinians

- ★ **26%** have a high school diploma or GED
- ★ **12%** have completed a bachelors or associates degree
- ★ **1 in 12** have served in the armed forces
- ★ **1 in 8** worked in the last 12 months
