- Conquering Cancer attendees will have the opportunity to network on an interactive virtual platform (Remo) with business leaders and scientists including hearing from American Cancer Society funded researchers.

#### Advancing Research, Innovation, Collaboration and Health Equity

Medical research and innovation went into overdrive in response to the COVID19 pandemic

Scientific discovery and innovation ecosystems are powering a revolution in cancer screening, early detection, diagnostics, and treatments.

However, the pandemic disrupted cancer research and clinical trials. It is critical for cancer research and innovation ecosystems to identify cancer earlier and treat more effectively – to save more lives. The pandemic exposed entrenched health disparities that exist in communities across the country.

- The 5-year relative survival rate is lower among Blacks/African-Americans than Whites for every stage of diagnosis in the four most common cancer sites.
- Studies show that individuals from the poorest U.S. counties have a 20% higher death rate than affluent counties.

As cancer prevention techniques, early detection technology, and targeted therapies and immunotherapies advance, we must also increase our commitment to health equity so all cancer patients will benefit.
