- What we are asking people to do is a personal and individual display. This could be to display the bags they create on their stairs, street, courtyard, balcony, etc. We are not asking anyone pull a permit or use a public space. Most importantly we'll ask you to take photos and post on social media with special hashtags to help bring us all together. This is how we are going to Bring Lights of Hope Across America.



- Our 2020 REVISED Lights of Hope Goal is \$15,000. We currently have raised almost \$4,000 to date. You all are rocking it!


