She is the Director of the Oklahoma TSET Phase I Program and serves as Chair for National Research Group (NRG) Immunotherapy Subcommittee. She is designated NCI Early-Stage Clinical investigator. She is board certified in hematology, medical oncology, and internal medicine.

She is a member of the American Society of Clinical Oncology, where she serves as a group member of the Gastrointestinal Guideline Advisory Board. Member. She is currently a member of the Data Safety and Monitoring Committee, and Chair of the Early Phase disease site committee, at the Stephenson Cancer Center.

Dr. Ulahannan completed a hematology-oncology fellowship at the National Cancer Institute/National Institutes of Health, Bethesda, Maryland. She completed an internal medicine residency at Johns Hopkins University, Sinai Hospital, Baltimore. She earned her Medical Degree and a Master's of Medicine from Sahlgrenska Akademin, Goteborg University in Sweden.
