ACT 254: Advancing Cancer Research and Health Equity



After three years of advocacy, House Bill 1300—now ACT 254—was signed into law, securing \$1 million for groundbreaking research led by the University of Hawai'i Cancer Center. Through its Multiethnic Cohort Study, this initiative will examine why cancer disproportionately impacts Native Hawaiians, Pacific Islanders, and Asian American communities, including Filipinos—a vital step toward achieving true health equity across our islands. By uncovering the root causes of cancer disparities, the data collected will help save lives, strengthen prevention strategies, improve early detection, and ensure every community has a fair and just opportunity to live a healthier, cancer-free future.
