How many Lights of Hope can I bring to DC?





To be the best stewards of our donor dollars AND be more environmentally conscious, we will be limiting the number of Lights of Hope set up at the Hope Walk.

The short answer: Those invited and planning to attend the 2024 Leadership Summit & Lobby Day (LS&LD) can display up to 20 of their Lights of Hope at the Hope Walk in Washington, DC.

More details: At a minimum, each state gets to send one person per Congressional District, plus their SLA & VSLA, plus a state staff partner to LS&LD. We used these numbers, multiplied by 20 bags per person to get the MAXIMUM number of bags that will come to DC from each state. We know not everyone will want to bring their maximum Lights of Hope bags to DC, so it's up to the state staff and volunteers to determine which bags are being displayed at the Hope Walk.

Important: These numbers do NOT include National or Regional staff members or Leadership volunteers (NAT, Board Members) we will work with those individuals separately.
