Hosting an At Home Display







Individual At-Home Displays

Each volunteer with a Lights of Hope DonorDrive page is encouraged to display their Lights of Hope at a time that works best for them during the months of August or September. They can be displayed in your own backyard. Or front yard. Or neighborhood park. Or balcony. Or sidewalk. Or courtyard. You get the point. Be creative and help us build Lights of Hope across America.

Community Involvement

By bringing this event into your community, you have the potential to involve neighbors, family members, and others who have not previously participated. Be sure to follow your state and local COVID guidelines, where applicable. At Home Displays are perfect for recruiting state-based sponsors and local media coverage, greatly expanding the impact of our event.

Lights of Hope Bags

ACS CAN volunteers are responsible for decorating their own Lights of Hope bags. There is an easy-to-access report inside the DonorDrive fundraising center that will provide all the information you need. A video training on how to pull the report in DonorDrive can be <u>found here</u> and written instructions can be <u>found here</u>.

Place orders for Lights of Hope bags through your ACS CAN Staff Partner. Please note that it can take up to 10 business days for them to arrive so plan accordingly. If you have Lights of Hope bags left over from previous years, please use them before ordering more.

Reminder: Per legal requirements, Relay For Life Luminaria bags may not be used for Lights of Hope.



Display Tips

- If your display is outdoors, ensure you have something to weigh down the bags. Suggestions include sand, rocks, marbles, children's toys, or working with a store to get canned goods donated.
- If you set up the display indoors or during daylight hours, there is no need for lights. If you want to 'light' the bags, a few places you can order battery tea lights or glow sticks from include: Amazon, Target, Party City, and most party supply stores. ACS CAN will not be shipping lights for your display.
- Showcase your sponsorship signs (if applicable). Make sure your sponsors see the display or share photos with them.
- Is there a landmark in your hometown where you can do a small display set up? That could make for great photos or a "pre-display" promotion to solicit a few additional donations.
- Using your DonorDrive app, you can create a QR code that can be scanned by anyone with a smart phone, taking them to your personal donation page for a day-of-event donation. Have a few extra bags on hand for these new donors to decorate.

Making your display more eco-friendly

- Bags
 - When you are done displaying your Lights of Hope, carefully fold your decorated bags and save them! Next year, when your 2023 donors return, you will already have bags decorated for many of the folks they want to honor or remember.
 - Only decorate with recyclable materials, so that your bags can eventually be recycled. This likely means no glitters, stickers, or stick-on decorations.
- Weighting your bags
 - Instead of using sand to keep your bags in place, consider asking a local grocer to donate canned goods. These can be delivered to a food pantry when you no longer need them, allowing the grocer to support two charities with one donation.
 - If you do choose to use sand, store it in reusable bags and use the same sand each year.
- Lights
 - Turn off your battery lights after the display and reuse them for years to come.
 - Use solar lights to avoid using batteries that end up in the landfill.
- What else?
 - Share your best ideas for reducing the environmental impact of Lights of Hope! We'll help to share them with others, to ensure we are all being good stewards of limited resources and the environment.











Money Collection

Funds raised through Lights of Hope enable ACS CAN to continue its mission to make fighting cancer a priority with lawmakers in your community, at your state legislature and in Congress. It very important that we keep track of all donations and ensure that all offline (cash/check) donations are turned in to ACS CAN promptly.

You have two options for collecting donations: by inviting friends and family to visit your DonorDrive page to make their donations online; or accepting the donation via cash/check (offline donation). All online donations to your personal page will automatically be entered. All offline donations need to be entered by you in the offline donations section.

All donations MUST be entered into DonorDrive before deadline on October 6th at 11:59pm ET. Once you have entered all of your offline donations on DonorDrive, please process all of your checks using the <u>Society Donations Batching Tool</u>. To assist with using the new tool, we have:

- o An <u>instructional video</u> on how to use the batching tool
- o A written step by step instructional guide

Photo Submission Tool

The deadline to be part of the nationwide 2023 Lights of Hope Photo Album is October 6th. We will do our best to include all photos. We are especially looking for photos depicting groups of Lights of Hope rather than individual bags.

Important Deadlines:

- Please work with your staff to order Lights of Hope bags 2 weeks before you need them.
- Sponsor signs must be ordered 4 weeks before you plan to display them.
- September 7th: Deadline to <u>submit photos</u> for a chance to be featured in the Lights of Hope Across America video compilation.
 - Note: you can (and should!) submit photos after this deadline to be included in the 2023 LOH Event Photo Album that will be shared post event.
- Fundraising Incentive Deadline: September 7, 2023 (11:59pm ET)
- DonorDrive closing Deadline: October 6, 2023 (11:59pm ET).
- October 6: Deadline to submit photos for our <u>2023 LOH Event Photo Album</u>.
