

eMaterial: Clinical-trial related questions from May-June ACS CAN Survivor Views survey. Note-findings detailed in the manuscript come from a subset of the overall survey, and only those used for the analysis in this manuscript are reported here. Demographic questions were part of the original cohort enrollment survey and are not reported here.

Clinical trials questions:

Which of the following best describes the setting of your facility where you received your cancer care?

- Rural
- Suburban
- Urban

At any time since being told you have cancer, have you talked to any of your providers about clinical trials to treat your cancer, its symptoms, or side effects?

- Yes
- No
- I'm not sure

At any time since being told you have cancer, have you been offered a chance to participate in a clinical trial to treat your cancer, its symptoms, or side effects or to reduce the risk of your cancer coming back?

- Yes
- No
- I'm not sure

Have you participated in a cancer clinical trial?

- Yes
