



Patient Costs for Stage I Breast Cancer by Type of Insurance





Patient Costs for Stage II Colorectal Cancer By Type of Insurance





Patient Costs for Stage IV Lung Cancer By Type of Insurance





Patient Costs for Stage I Breast Cancer by Month





Patient Costs for Stage II Colorectal Cancer by Month







*The relative standard error for this category was greater than 30 percent.


