For 21 years, the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) has engaged volunteers to make their voices heard to influence public policy change that saves lives. In 2022, we achieved meaningful impact in our goal to improve the lives of people with cancer and their families nationwide by advocating at every level of government to end cancer as we know it, for everyone.

Led the cancer community to secure a total of \$7.32 billion for cancer research at the National Cancer Institute (NCI), including a \$408 million increase as part of a \$2.5 billion increase for biomedical research at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to help lead to innovative future therapies.

Protected and secured **\$1.93 billion** in state appropriations through advocacy to help fund cancer research and programs that reduce the tobacco burden and increase access to screenings.


