- Black women have 40% higher breast cancer death rates than non-Hispanic white women.
- Black people have the highest death rate and the lowest survival rate of any racial or ethnic group for most cancers.
- Cancer is the leading cause of death in Hispanics and Asian Americans.

#### **Details**

- 1. This program is targeted to Professional Services firms Legal, Consulting, Accounting, Tax, etc. Professional Service firms make their revenue from billable hours charged to a client.
- 2. The success of this idea comes in the number of employees that participate. The individual donation is small but the numbers add up quickly.
- 3. This program can be executed in two ways:
  - Firm Sell the program to a firm who will activate via Partners or HR across all employees.
  - Individual Sell the program to a key individual who will activate their network for donations.
