


Funding the Future: Wyoming Impact

Our Mission

Improve the lives of people with cancer and their families through advocacy, research, and patient support, to ensure everyone has an opportunity to prevent, detect, treat and survive cancer.

Impact: Advocacy

The American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) is making cancer a top priority for public officials and candidates at the federal, state and local levels.



2024 Legislative Priorities

Increase funding for state breast and cervical cancer screening programs, increase funding for tobacco prevention/cessation, expand access to affordable health care, and educate on colorectal screening.



\$2,500,000

Additional funding secured for Missouri's Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Program, saving the state \$21M in future health expenditures and preventing 1,000 kids from smoking as adults.

Impact: Research

Since 1991, we have invested \$3.1 billion in cancer research contributing to 3.5 million fewer cancer deaths.



\$2.99 million

invested in cancer research grants
in Wyoming since 1970.

Impact: Patient Support

Providing multiple support programs for people with cancer and their caregivers, including lodging and transportation during treatment.
